As you are aware Monday 13th May is the start of SATs (Statutory Assessment Tests) time for **ALL** the country's Year 6 pupils **and your child will be taking part**. On the reverse of this letter is a time table of the tests for your information.

All the Year 6 children at Howard have been working hard with Miss Blackford, Mr Shahzar and the team of additional teachers and support staff in an effort to ensure they are ready. They have been busy doing a lot of revision in class and they have all been completing revision homework. We would like to thank those of you who have been helping the children at home.
